Kahnawà:ke Tourism was invited to attend the Mohawk Artist Village at the World University Games in Lake Placid, New York in January. We shared what Kahnawà:ke Tourism has to offer visitors to our community; guided tours of our historic village, visits to our museums, dining in our restaurants, golfing at our clubs and shopping in our local stores.



At the Mohawk Artist Village we displayed a 215+ Moccasin Travelling Exhibit to facilitate conversations about the discoveries at residential schools across Canada. For some visitors it was their first introduction in regard to this topic. Our facilitators are knowledgeable on the subject matter and explained the impacts on this painful part of Indigenous history. The 215+ Moccasins represented children that did not return home from residential schools, although this number is the first report of remains found, sadly it is much more today. The moccasins provided a visual representation for our visitors and gave them an opportunity to ask deeper questions.

Members of our team had the opportunity to experience the World University Games and to watch the world's incredible athletes competing in events such as ski jumping, figure skating, hockey, biathlon, speed skating and so much more. We look forward to welcoming guests from around the world to our beautiful community.

# MIRELA'S

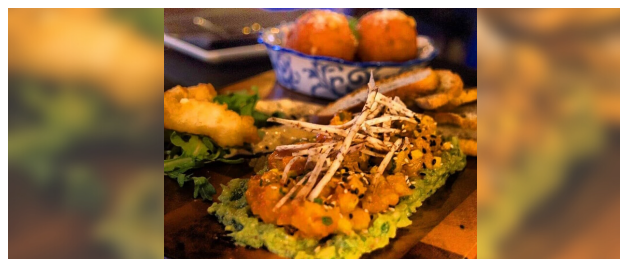

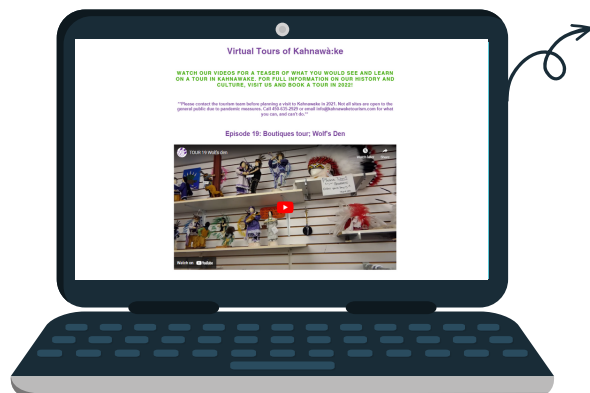
